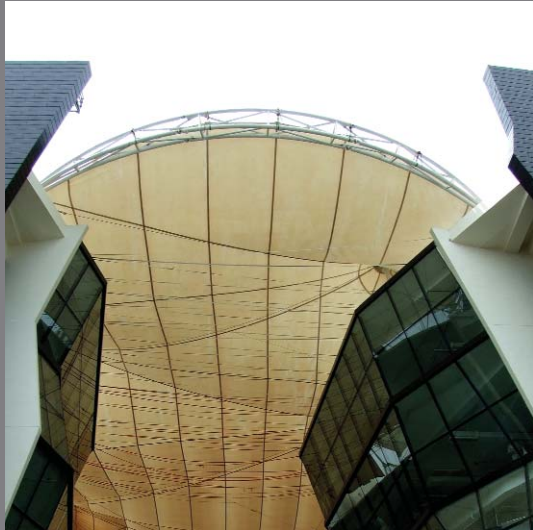




Case Study: LASALLE-SIA College of the Arts, Singapore

The New City Campus for the LASALLE College of the Arts comprises a 6-storey iconic institutional building with 2 basements and a construction floor area of 53,000 m². The proposed new city campus of this leading international arts college has modern state-of-the-art teaching, performing, theatre and exhibition facilities. The project was subject of a design competition and it was displayed at the Venice Biennale exhibition (La Biennale di Venezia) in year 2004.
