The new National Library of Singapore is one of the most outstanding national libraries internationally, housing the largest reference library collections in South East Asia. It also houses the National Arts Council's Drama Centre of 614-seat theatre. The development is internationally acknowledged for its architectural features, green building features, and innovative intelligent and IT features. The building has been the recipient of the Green Mark Platinum award, the highest award accorded for green buildings in Singapore.
