Project

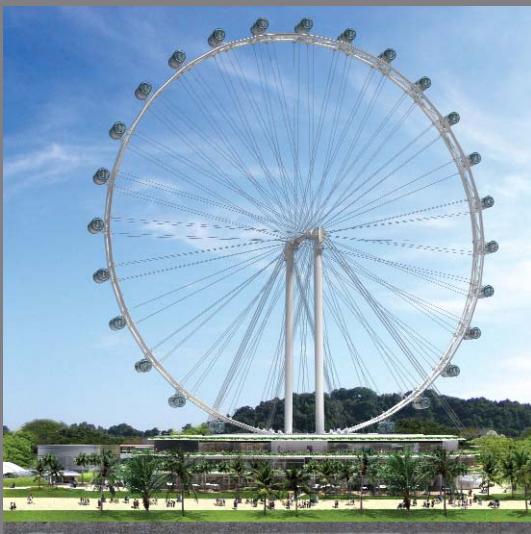
The S\$160m Singapore Flyer project is the world's largest Giant Observation Wheel (GOW) under construction, with a diameter of 150m and 28 capsules each holding up to 35 passengers. The GOW sets on a 13,000m² retail base with car park facilities provided on an adjacent building. The construction contract is a turnkey EPC contract based on a design and build and contractor-financing arrangement.
