Overview

The Benaroya Concert Hall accommodates two performing halls in a complex that is thoroughly integrated into downtown Seattle. The rectangular form of the 2,500-seat S Mark Taper Foundation Auditorium and the circular Samuel and Althea Stroum Grand Lobby that surrounds it are at the center of the site. The project also includes a block-long glass-enclosed arcade along Third Avenue which was designed to link the building's various components and offer additional retail space.
