#### Overview

The Auckland War Memorial Museum is one of New Zealand's most important national museums and war memorials. Its collections concentrate on New Zealand history, natural history, as well as military history.

The museum is also one of the most iconic Auckland buildings, constructed in the neo-classicist style, and sitting on a grassed plinth (the remains of a dormant volcano) in the Auckland Domain, a large public park close to the Auckland central business district.

Rider Hunt were involved in the development of an on site storage facility for the Museums 5 million objects, a special exhibition hall the size of five tennis courts, an auditorium, learning centre and 700 person roof top events centre. All beneath a copper and glass dome roof in a suspended three storey 'bowl' structure.
